See sites where heroes and heroines made history...but missed the history books. Experience Mother Emanuel A.M. E. Church stories that have faded from memory over the centuries. Hear folktales once told only in secret whispers. Learn stories of resistance before, during and after Reconstruction. Be inspired and enthralled by this fascinating revelation of the Charleston you never knew. Come walk with us... on an exceptional tour that reveals stories previously buried in oral histories and old newspapers.



Ghost of Charleston Walking Tour:

Charleston's role in the developing South goes without saying, but did you know that Charleston also had a darker haunted side to its history. On this tour you will enter the lush, spellbinding Unitarian Church Graveyard built in 1772. Real time hauntings occur only a handful of times a year. However, since 1996, when we started what is now Charleston's oldest ghost tour, spirits in the Unitarian Church Graveyard have reached out to many people on our tour in visual, tactile and auditory ways. There is no experience like walking enchanted Charleston at night, listening to our supernatural stories, and encountering what you will see and hear in the Unitarian Church Graveyard.



Aiken-Rhett House Tour:

Built in 1820 by merchant John Robinson, the Aiken-Rhett House is nationally significant as one of the best-preserved townhouse complexes in the nation. Vastly expanded by Governor and Mrs. William Aiken, Jr. in the 1830s and again in the 1850s, the house and its outbuildings include a kitchen, the original slave quarters, carriage block and back lot. The house and its surviving furnishings offer a compelling portrait of urban life in antebellum Charleston, as well as a Southern politician, slaveholder and industrialist. The house spent 142 years in the Aiken family's hands before being sold to the Charleston Museum and opened as a museum house in 1975.

Magnolia's Restaurant:

Come dine at one of Charleston's most upscale southern establishments in the historic district.
