### Options in Dallas :



#### **Premier Transportation:**

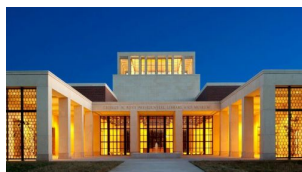

#### **George W. Bush Presidential Library & Museum:**

Visit George W. Bush Presidential Library & Museum, with museum exhibits of the 43rd President of the United States that include A Nation Under Attack (9/11), Life in the White House (2001-2009), the interactive Decision Points Theater, a full-size replica of the White House Oval Office, and a massive 20-foot-tall, 360-degree LED screen showing high-definition multimedia clips blending art, history, and entertainment. Also on display throughout the museum are numerous documents and artifacts of this 43rd President.



#### **Holocaust & Human Rights Museum:**

Founded in 1984 by a group of Dallas area Holocaust Survivors, the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum is dedicated to teaching the history of the Holocaust and advancing human rights to combat prejudice, hatred, and indifference. This museum filled with moving images is a reminder to us all that "Those that can't remember the past are condemned to repeat it." – George Santayana



#### **Perot Museum of Nature and Science:**

Your entrance ticket in the Perot Museum of Nature and Science allows you to visit all 11 Exhibit Halls, including many interactive activities occurring daily at the museum. Whether you are a lover of engineering, technology or conservation, you are sure to walk away mesmerized by the sheer scope of this museum. Whether or not you have children, this is a must see and do attraction in Dallas! You'll only be disappointed if you don't spend a good part of the day here!



#### **The Sixth Floor Museum:**

This is Dallas' number one attraction. The Sixth Floor Museum is the site where President John F. Kennedy was assassinated and now host a collection of memorabilia of this fateful day that shocked a country and world, ending the presidency of the USA's youngest president. Make sure you plan at least two to three hours to visit this impressive audio and visual collections. Complimenting your visit is the audio-guide in French (included in your price) to aid you in understanding the various displays throughout the museum.

### Options in Dallas (cont) :



#### **SouthFork Ranch (Parker, TX):**

Just 45 minutes from Dallas, South Fork Ranch was the ranch made famous by the television series "Dallas" from 1978-1991. Many of the scenes were filmed here and you will learn more about this show and ranch on your 45-minute guided tour through the house and ranch.

### Options in Fort Worth :



#### **Stockyard Total Experience:**

Not sure what you want to do while in Fort Worth, then this pass is a must! This pass includes: Entrance to the Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame Museum, Entrance to the Stockyards Museum, Meet & Greet with the Drovers of the Fort Worth Herd (3:15PM), Entrance to Billy Bob's Texas (until 5PM) with a photo opt (per paying visitor) in Western attire. Add the Wrangler Walking Tour (not included in the pass) for a complete and authentic Western/Cowboy experience!



#### **The Wrangler Walking Tour of Historic Fort Worth Stockyards:**

Texas is probably most associated with Cowboys than any other state and this city is the Cowboy Capital of the Texas. On this 45 minute to 1 hour Walking Tour, learn how this city became the largest livestock trading center in the USA. On your tour you will be given an orientation of the various attractions in the Stockyard, such as the Cowtown Coliseum where a rodeo is taken place each Friday and Saturday nights, the Texas Cowboy Hall of Fame, the hotel with Bonnie & Clyde once stayed and of course not to be missed the daily cattle drive down the historic Main Street – a great photo opportunity to show your friends back home. After your tour spend the remainder of the day visiting the various shops, bars and restaurants along Main Street just steps away.



#### **Cowboys and Culture Bus Tour of Fort Worth:**

Depart the Fort Worth Visitor's Center for your 2 hour cultural and western tour of Fort Worth. This tour gives the visitor a overall tour of three unique districts in Fort Worth: the Cultural District with its 5 world renown museums, the Stockyards, with its twice daily Longhorn (cattle) drive and surrounding western ambiance and Downtown, with its vibrant and lively scene of restaurants, galleries and shops. After your tour, you will have a better understanding why many call Fort Worth "THE" place to visit in Texas!



#### **Cowtown Coliseum Rodeo:**

If you have one activity to do while in Fort Worth, this should be the activity to do! Every Friday and Saturday night, the Cowtown Coliseum puts on a rodeo and competition of the young and upcoming cowboys. See barrel racing, bull riding, roping and various other rodeo attractions. We have four types of tickets for your enjoyment: General Admission, Box Seats (first two rows of the arena), Premium/Preferred Box Seats (in the center of the first two rooms of the arena) and VIP Ticket (with access to the bar where one can bring their alcoholic beverage to their seat to enjoy the rodeo).

### Options in Fort Worth (cont) :



#### **Downtown Fort Worth Walking Tour:**

Downtown Fort Worth is a collage of both old and modern in this vibrant city. On your hour tour, hear the interesting history and legends of the "City Where the West Begins". Your guide will point out joints where Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid frequented. Not only Cowboy folklore will be recounted, but your guide will point out many of the modern buildings and other places of interest on this tour.



#### **John Wayne Exhibit : An American Experience:**

Sprawling over 10,000 square feet, the John Wayne: An American Experience exhibit is structured to give you an intimate tour of the life of John Wayne. Starting with his early childhood and career, each room highlights an aspect of The Duke's legacy. All patrons will have exclusive access to never-before-seen family photos and correspondences curated by the Wayne family in order to give guests a holistic view of the icon, whose values translate both on the silver screen and off.

#### **The Houston Museum of Natural Science:**

Most museums focus on one specific collection, not this museum. The Houston Museum of Natural Science is the largest Natural Science in the USA with multiple unique collections such as: Fabergé (the largest and most extensive collection in the world), Hall of Egypt (one of the most diverse collections of over 6000 years of history), Paleo Hall (the largest dinosaur collection in the world), Energy Exhibit (a very impressive mind-blowing exhibit of energy and technology) and many more exhibits that are included in your entrance.



Add-On: Cockrell Butterfly Center

Enter a three-story glass atrium with a 50-foot waterfall cascading just steps away from you in this simulated rain forest, all the while admiring the beautiful and fascinating butterfly collection from around the world on display year-round.



#### **Space Center Houston:**

Houston's most popular attraction, the Space Center Houston has been the "Mission Control" of all space exploration missions since the 1960's. Various exhibit halls focus on different aspects of space exploration. Not to be missed (and included in your entrance) is your tram ride to "Mission Control" where history was made in 1969 with the Apollo 11, the first lunar landing, which was manned (coordinated) right here! This attraction fills up quickly, so it is highly recommended in reserving this package in advance to avoid missing this one-of-a-kind exhibit!

### Options in San Antonio :



#### **San Antonio Walking Tour:**

This private tour in French will begin at the famous Alamo, where the Mexican army was successful in capturing the symbol of the young Texas Republic, however, not with great casualties on both sides. Your Walking tour will continue to San Fernando Cathedral crossing the River Walk with its numerous restaurants, bars and shops. Then your tour will stop in front of the Spanish Governor's Palace, dating from as early as 1722 and ending at the Mercado, the largest Mexican market in the USA. This three hour tour will definitely give you a better understanding of the importance San Antonio played in the history of Texas.



#### **San Antonio City Tour & Spanish Missions:**
