### Day Four - January 2nd, 2023 - Morgan Library & Museum and Holiday Lights Dinner Cruise

- This morning, you'll have an opportunity to attend service at **St. Patrick Cathedral**. Enjoy a leisurely **breakfast on own** and **free time** to shop in Times Square.
- Arrive at the **Morgan Library & Museum**, a major exhibition venue for fine art, literature, and music, one of New York's great historic centers. In 1924 J. P. Morgan, Jr. gave his father's extraordinary library to the public. The most influential financier in this country's history, Pierpont Morgan was also a voracious collector. He bought on an astonishing scale, collecting art objects in virtually every medium, including the rare books, manuscripts, drawings, prints, and ancient artifacts that are the core of The Morgan Library & Museum's holdings.
- Arrive at **Shubert Theater** and take your seats for **Broadway's "To Kill a Mockingbird"**. Inspired by Lee's own childhood in Alabama, *To Kill a Mockingbird* features one of literature's towering symbols of integrity and righteousness in the character of Atticus Finch, based on Lee's own father. The character of Scout, based on Lee herself, has come to define youthful innocence—and its inevitable loss—for generation after generation of readers around the world.
- Arrive back at the hotel to rest and freshen up prior to boarding the European-inspired, glass-enclosed **Bateaux New York**.
- Enjoy an upscale **Holiday Lights Dinner Cruise** along the New York Harbor featuring a 3-course plated dinner with attentive table service and unobstructed, breath taking, panoramic views of the New York City skyline and Empire State Building, Brooklyn Bridge, the Statue of Liberty and more.
